### **India INX Signs Strategic MoUs with Taiwan Stock Exchange, AFRINEX, and ICSI to Enhance Global Market Access, Strengthen IFSC Ecosystem**

During the Global Securities Market Conclave (GSMC) 2.0, hosted by the International Financial Services Centres Authority (IFSCA) in Gandhinagar, GIFT City, above mentioned MoUs were exchanged in the presence of senior leadership from the respective institutions - **Ms. Brenda Hu, Senior Vice President – Taiwan Stock Exchange & COO of the Asian Asset Management Centre** representing TWSE, **Mr. Thapelo Tsheole, Chief Executive Officer of AFRINEX Exchange**, and **CS Ashish Mohan, Secretary of ICSI** - underscoring high-level institutional commitment and strategic alignment.

Collectively, these strategic collaborations significantly enhance India INX's global exposure and international footprint, accelerating cross-border capital integration, expanding global market access, and reinforcing institutional depth within GIFT IFSC in line with emerging global capital market standards along with, structuring India INX's as a gateway for global capital market development.
